The School Day

Our day begins at 8.50am when the teachers open the class doors and welcome your child into school.

Wraparound

The Ark offers a breakfast club from 7.55am and after school club until 6.00pm, during term time. With a safe, nurturing environment, The Ark provides a variety of fun activities for your child to get involved in, from baking to crafts and outdoor activities.
